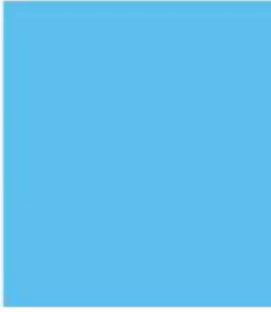

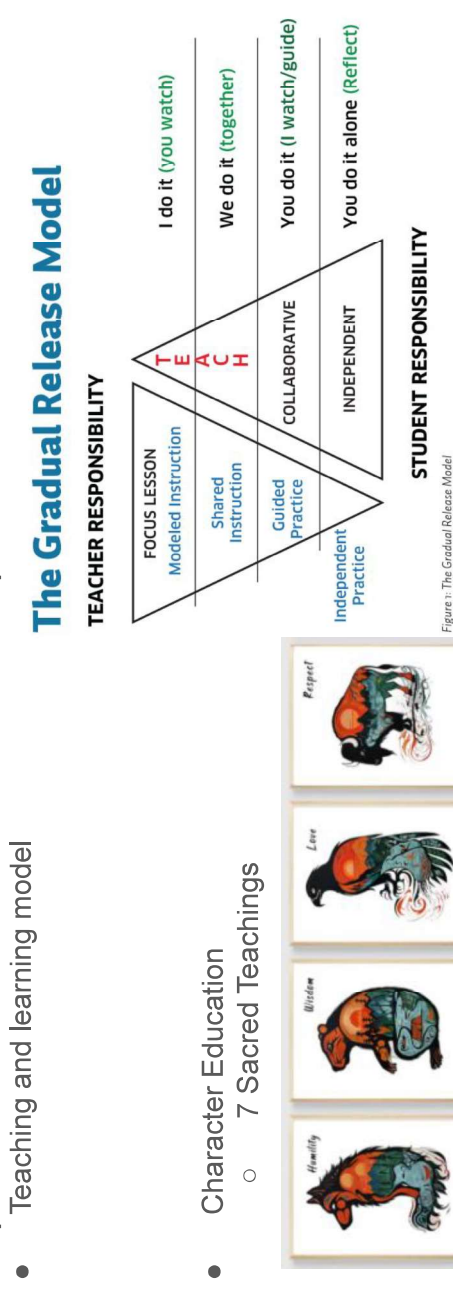

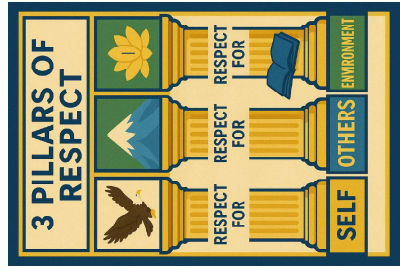

Uniform Expectations & FAQ

- Formal uniforms are worn on:
 - The 1st day of the week (Mon for M/W, Tues for Tu/Th)
 - Assembly days

- Navy skort



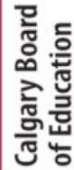
(Not gender specific)

Uniform Purchasing Windows

As directed by the Calgary Board of Education, all CBE schools are required to purchase uniforms during set Purchasing Windows each school year.

2025-2026 School Year Purchasing Windows

Summer Window:

Wed July 2nd, 2025 – Fri October 31st, 2025.

Winter Window:

Wed December 17th, 2025, to Sat January 31st 2026.

Spring Window:

Wed April 15th, 2026, to Sun May 31st, 2026.

Only during these Purchasing Windows will families be able to purchase embroidered or school specific uniform items.

School specific items will not be kept on hand for purchasing outside of the windows.

Items can be purchased in store, online or through our Call Centre. Returns & Exchanges will be processed as per company policy.

Items will only be available over the counter for the Summer Purchasing Window.

All other Purchasing Windows will be by order only, and Uniform items will then be embroidered to order. Orders will be reviewed and actioned every two weeks during the Purchasing Window and shipped once complete.

Samples will be available Year-Round to try on; we recommend visiting outside of the Purchasing Window for fitting purposes.

Please note that outside of the Purchasing Windows, Call Centre ordering and your E-Store will not be available, and the Calgary Location will not have stock available to sell.

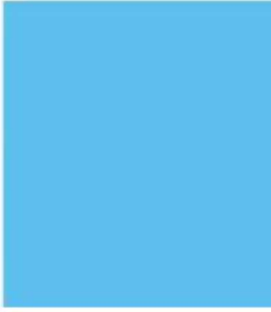
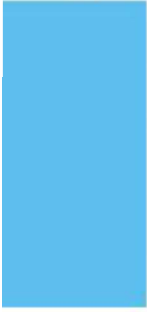
Returns & Exchanges:

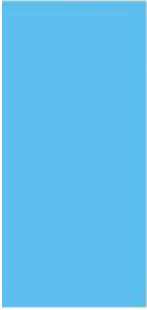

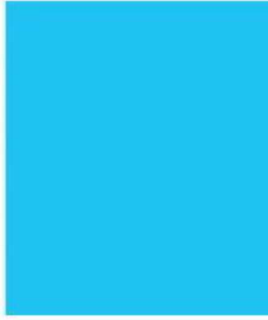

Lunchroom Registration

What lunch supervision is:

- Optional program for students in Grades 1-6 and full-day kindergarten programs for an annual fee.
 - K-4 require direct supervision during the lunch hour
- Only students that have registered and paid the lunch supervision fee can access the service:
 - Lunch supervision fees directed to paying to providing supervisors
 - Use of service indicates that the Parent/Guardian accepts the terms and the responsibility to pay the annual fee.
 - CBE fee waiver (when applicable)

What lunch supervision is not:

- Providing food or snacks; students are required to bring a lunch.
- Access to hot water, microwave, dishes, utensils or other cooking facilities.
- **Healthy Hunger**

Transportation | Bussing

- Bus and stop assignments available through your [My CBE/Powerschool](#) account. These may not be available until late August.
- These assignments are based on the student's primary home address. May not be available until August
- Congregated stop model. More information can be found on the CBE Website under alternative program transportation.

Registration Now Open

- **Register** for the bus by **Sunday, June 22nd**. Information regarding transportation pre-registration is available now on the CBE website. Registration is now open.
- **Pre-registering is important** - the transportation team builds the routes over the summer months
- **If not pre-registered**, your child will not be able to ride the bus on the first full day of school (New registrations in September can take up to 6 weeks to be processed)
- **Yellow bus fee was \$130 per kindergarten student (gr. 1 -9 is \$260) for 2024/25.**



Transportation | Bussing

On the 1st Full Day of School:

- We recommend you have your child ride the bus on their first full day of school, if possible. This will help you and your child to become familiar with the bus route.
- Many parents like to follow their child's bus to the school on their first bus day so that they are familiar with the route
- Familiarize your child with the bus route (indicated by a letter) they are assigned to
 - this is sent out by the transportation team in August

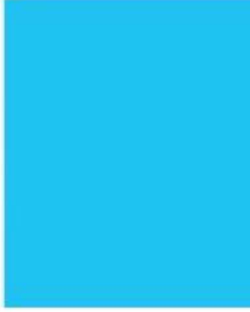

Drop-off and Pick-up

Safety is our priority

- **Stay** with your child until supervision starts
- **Be ready** to pick up your child by the specified end time
- **Teacher dismisses** each child after ensuring student contact with the parent/caregiver
- **Inform** the school if it is not you or a legal guardian picking up your child (written, phone call or add to student demographic verification).





Drop-off and Pick-up

Safety is our priority

- **Follow the Signs**

- Traffic rules (J-walking, speed limit, no parking areas, crosswalks)
- The staff parking lot off limits (walking or parking)

- **Community**

- neighbour driveways, back alley off-limits for parking,
- Be patient

- Attending School Council meetings allows you to be involved in and share your voice in our school direction and contributes to enriching the learning experiences for all students.

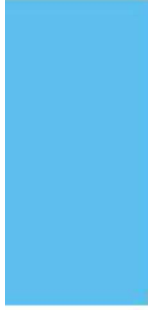

Enhanced Supports

The classroom teacher is at the centre of your child's learning team and is supported by a school learning team. Based on classroom needs, each kindergarten program will also be supported by a multidisciplinary team that works with large and small groups in the classroom.

This team may consist of:

- Education Assistants or Early Childhood Practitioners
- Early Learning Strategists
- Speech-Language Pathologists (SLPs)
- Psychologists
- Occupational Therapists (OTs)
- Physiotherapists (PTs)
- School Family Liaison (SFL)

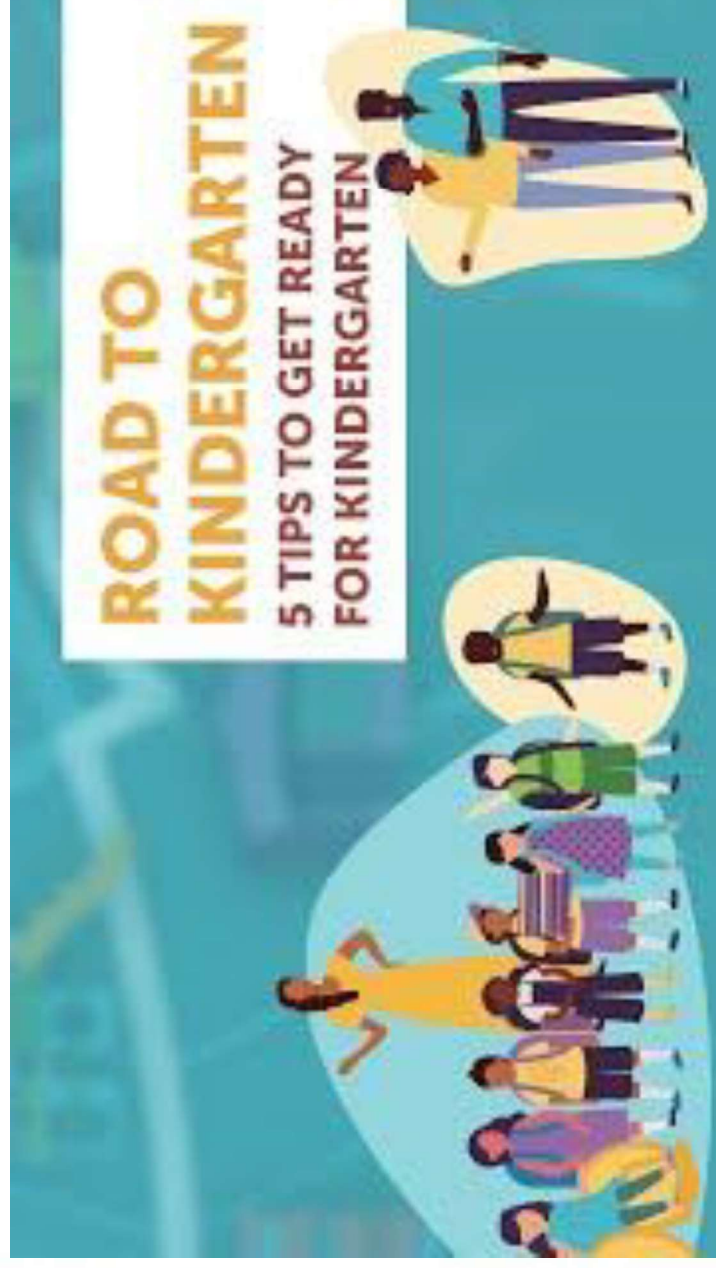
